Finding the Barn Quilts

The barn quilts have been grouped by location with Broadway as the east to west division and 15th Street as the north to south division. Using your phone or vehicle navigation system to navigate will make the barn quilts easier to find. Many folks tell us it is fun to explore new streets and neighborhoods that they don’t often have an occasion to visit. You don’t have to view them all in one trip—unless you want to! The barn quilts will be displayed from August 13 through September 30.
