Combining photography, instant access to the Missouri River and the popularity of Riverboat Days makes this annual event one of the most popularly participated and anticipated exhibits. The exhibit is open to photographers of all experience and age levels.

Cash prizes are awarded for Best in Show, Honorable Mention and People's Choice. Photos are judged on four categories: Theme, Composition, Lighting and Originality to determine a Best of Show and Honorable Mention winner. Businesses and individuals are encouraged to support local photographers by making a Promise to Purchase one of the photos on display.

Best in Show and Honorable Mention will be awarded on August 7, 2020 and streamed live on Facebook and Instagram. The People's Choice award winner will be announced at the close of the exhibit.
