The Mighty Mo Photo Show is an area photographic competition designed to complement Yankton's Annual Riverboat Days celebration and to encourage and recognize the talents of area photographers. You are invited to participate.

THEME: *Art in Architecture*

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Open to all photographers living in South Dakota, Iowa, or Nebraska.
- Entries do NOT have to include the Missouri River in the composition of the photo.
- All photographic media, techniques, and styles accepted.
- Artists may enter up to four photographs in the competition.
- All entries must be ready for hanging on a [heavy classic hook](#) and must be labeled.
- Label must have:
 1. Artist's name
 2. Title of work
 3. Sale price
- Accepted works will not be withdrawn from the exhibition before the show ends.

Delivery of Work:

Entries are to be delivered to G.A.R. Hall Art Gallery | 508 Douglas | Yankton, SD.

Entries may arrive as early as June 25 and no later than June 29.

Entries may be picked up August 22nd and 23rd. Hours to deliver or pick up are Monday through Friday 1-5pm or by appointment.

Sales:

Sales of work in the exhibit will be encouraged by Yankton Area Arts. Sales are subject to a 30% commission, so prices should be set accordingly. The submission entries presuppose the right to photograph accepted works for publicity.

July 6 – Exhibit Opens (there will be a First Friday event and reception that night)

August 3 – First Friday Reception and Awards Ceremony 5:00-7:00 p.m.

August 21 – Exhibit closes

August 22-23 – Deadline for reclaiming entries

September 1 – Artists are paid for any sales
